- We comply with rules, regulations, etc.
- Complicit: involved with others in an activity that is unlawful or morally wrong.

Sol. Here we have a spelling error. The correct spelling is 'strategies'.

Sol. 'Extended' should be followed by 'to' and not by 'for'.

e.g. I extended my help to everybody.

S7. Ans.(d)

Sol. 'Survival' should make way for 'survived'. 'Survival' is a noun, which is not required her. So, 'survived' which is a verb should be used here.

e.g. Many people survived in the massive earthquake that hit Nepal.

Sol. Modal 'should' is followed by V_1 . So, 'resorting' should be removed and we should use 'resort'.

e.g. One should not resort to thievery or anything else like this.
